## **Tent Care**

All troop tents include:

- 1. Plastic ground cloth
- 2. Rain fly
- 3. Six stakes with bag
- 4. Three poles with bag
- 5. Tent bag

The troop expects the above to be returned when you are finished using the tent.

The tent manufacture recommends the following procedure for storing the tent. Do not depart from the manufacture recommendations.

The tent must be clean of any debris and air dried before it is returned. Do not stuff tent is bag.

Never leave a wet tent in the tent bag, it must be removed as soon as you arrive home and hung outside in the sun. If it is raining out, hang the tent in the basement or garage. Never put a tent in the drier.

- Fold the tent, fly and plastic ground cloth into thirds with the door open.
- Place the stakes inside the pole bag with the poles.
- Roll up the tent around the pole bag in the direction of the door.

(This will release any air trapped inside the tent)

Like any troop equipment, the tent must be returned at the next troop meeting. If you are unable to attend the meeting please make arrangements with the Quartermaster or Equipment Coordinator to drop off the equipment to their house.
